Chimney Fire inspections: This service evaluates the integrity of the Fireplace and chimney structure after being subject to a Creosote fire. This service includes specific inspection of the chimney and/or the location of the fire.

Earthquake Assessment Inspections: This service includes a complete examination of the fireplace and chimney system after a sudden event. This inspection includes a thorough investigation of critical components of the fireplace system and appropriate repair options.

Litigation Support & Consulting Services: This service includes: Consulting, professional witness, Deposition, Testimony, Arbitration, Investigation, Construction Coordination, and on-site inspections.

Construction Specifications: This service supplies technical information from the beginning of the project through completion. This includes sizing units appropriate for the desired use, suggestions of location within building, installation types, framing requirements, and proper installation.

Fire Investigation: This is a forensic look at conditions that may have caused the fire loss. It evaluates the fireplace, chimney, vent, and decorative appliance to assist in determining the cause and the area of origin. This service might include on-site inspection, code review, photo documentation, written report, and litigation support.
